Cathi and I were video-chatting with Bobby and Taylor, when the conversation was put on hold because their youngest (Titus) had crawled up on a coffee table. At 15 months of age, he was very proud of his accomplishment, but he was also in some serious peril. When Bobby picked him up from his new found perch, he was angry. He wanted to be on that table and was oblivious to the fact that he was probably about to fall.

In those moments it is pointless to try to reason with your kids isn't it? Hey, I feed you. I clothe you. I stay up all night with you when you get sick. I work hard for you. I look out for you. I make sacrifices for you. They don't understand that; and, they do not appreciate that.



I have some bird feeders at my house. There's one for Baltimore Orioles, Finches, Hummingbirds, Cardinals and then a couple for all the others like Blue Jays, Crackles, Sparrows, Red-wing Blackbirds, and anything else that comes through. Right now, these birds are ravenous.



Keeping these feeders clean and full takes time, but of course, every time I go out to take care of matters, they all fly away like I am going to harm them. I want to say, "Hey, I feed you. I put all of these things up for you. I look out for you. I clean up after you. Do you actually think that I am going to harm you?" But of course, they don't understand or appreciate that. It's not like they've ever thanked me either.



Most of you had a place to stay last night; and, you know where you are going to stay tonight. You ate food today; and, you probably have food in the refrigerator for tomorrow. You are able to read this note and understand these sentences. Like Titus and these birds, we have a Father and a Provider who gives us what we need and more. In these moments, when He moves us off the coffee table or does something else that we do not understand, we are quick to doubt His wisdom or motives. Even when He wants to be with us, we are prone to be afraid. Yet, if our heavenly Father cares about the sparrows (and He does), how much more does He care for the ones His own Son died for.
