Classes begin Wednesday September 4, 2019 unless otherwise noted.

General Electives

- **Exploring Membership:** In this class we cover the four things that unite us: 1) Our Salvation, 2) Our Statements, 3) Our Strategy, and 4) Our Structure. **This class is required for membership.**
- **Studies in Ephesians:** Ephesians deals with both doctrine and life. Students who engage in this class will learn not only about Paul's intent in writing this letter and the details of its development, but will learn how to think about their own life. Teacher: Terry O'Brien.
- **Biblical Counseling Training Track #1:** This course is designed to introduce students to the theological and methodological foundations of Biblical Counseling. We will discuss what Biblical Counseling is, why we do it, how it differs from other approaches to counseling, and some basic elements of how we do it. Textbook: *A Theology of Biblical Counseling* by Heath Lambert. Teacher: Dave Dunham
- **GriefShare:** This program is designed to help and encourage those who are grieving the loss of a loved one. This weekly seminar and support group is designed to help you rebuild your life. - **DivorceCare:** DivorceCare is a biblical DVD seminar for those who are separated or divorced, dealing with related issues such as reconciliation, remarriage, forgiveness, and the effect of divorce on children and families. Textbook: DivorceCare Workbook

- **Die Hard Sins: How to Fight Wisely Against Destructive Daily Habits:** Christians need to fight both big, obvious sins and commonplace, familiar sins, which can sneak in and become the hardest of all to kill. This study defines such diehard sins, presents an understandable overall doctrine of sin, and lays out a method for change that pits Christ and his provisions against the subtle, elusive sins that seem so un-killable. - **Precepts: Daniel Part 1 – Living Out a Biblical Worldview:** Many Christians today feel overwhelmed living a lifestyle that pleases our God. It seems hard, frustrating, tiring, disheartening, and lonely. And guess what? It is. But you're not the only one. Throughout God's Word are champions who were sold out for Him, no matter the cost. Threatened with death, Daniel stuck to his guns and refused to adopt a pagan lifestyle. His worldview had God at the center, and he lived it out, even under extreme pressure to change.
