General Electives - **Wednesdays**

- **Exploring Membership:** In this class, we cover the four things that unite us: 1) Our Salvation, 2) Our Statements, 3) Our Strategy, and 4) Our Structure. **This class is required for membership.**
- **Studies in I Kings:** Join us for a survey of the book of 1 Kings. Participants will learn not only about the book, but it's placement in the redemptive historical timeline, and its usefulness for Christians today. Teacher: Terry O'Brien
- **Biblical Counseling Training Track #3:** This course is designed to help students who have taken tracks #1 and #2 to think through particular counseling situations.
