

Small Group Questions from July 24, 2022

Read Text: 1 Samuel 21-22:5

1. Discuss your overall reaction to the message from Sunday. Did anything “stick with you” throughout this past week?
2. What is a “wilderness” situation that you have experienced in life? How has God been present with you in the midst of it? What made it difficult to see God in the “wilderness”?
3. One of the themes of this text is God’s faithfulness in spite of our self-dependence. In what ways do you attempt to live as if everything depended on you? How have you experienced God’s faithfulness in spite of your self-reliance?
4. This text reminds us that God prepares us for His work in ways that we least expect. Why do we sometimes feel like things are out of God’s control? What surprising events, things, or people has God used in your life to prepare you for future ministry? How can that history help you to face the future?
