1. With the addition of *Cornerstone Connection*, our ability to communicate with groups like the greeters, or the choir, or an individual ABF class has really improved. One way we are using CC is to email the quarterly letter instead of mailing it out. Since we are now emailing that letter, it's very important that you are signed up for CC so you can stay in the know. Click [here](#) to sign up today. We will continue to mail the 4th Quarter Letter and include giving statements, but the other quarters will be emailed. Keep in mind, you can check your giving records 24/7 on CC.

2. I already mentioned that Bob's house has sold. When we met back in April, we approved the selling of the house. At this time the paperwork is working through the system, and we (the church technically owns the house) should close next week.

3. Back in the day, when we met in the gym for church services, we sat on red chairs. Once we moved into the current Worship Center in the 2000s, we started to re-upholster those chairs with purple fabric. That process has now been completed with a total of 400 or so chairs re-upholstered. If you happen to still have any seats or backs at home, please return those ASAP as we are closing up that project this month. Thank you to all the volunteers who worked to strip the old fabric and cut the new fabric (especially Therese Geer) for the chairs!

4. One of the items that our Finance Team Chairman, John Hutek, and I highlighted at the meeting was our church budget. We raised our budget this year by \$150,000. That equates to about \$3,000 more per week than 2016. Currently we are receiving about \$2,000 more per week compared to last year's budgeted giving. Thank you! Will you help us bring in that extra \$1,000 weekly difference?

5. Our Sunday Morning Worship Services are now being streamed live on YouTube. Our target audience for the stream is the mom or dad who is home with a sick kid. The stream is not meant to be a professional production; but, if you are home with a sick kid, it beats not being here at all! You can find the stream [here](#) or you can search for it on YouTube using our church name, city, and state. We will also post the link on the webpage later this week.

6. Finally, our Staff Recognition Night was a big success. Thank you to the many volunteers that set up chairs, scooped ice cream, did the technical stuff, and/or participated in the game. Plus, we were able to successfully surprise and, more importantly, honor Denise. Thank you
