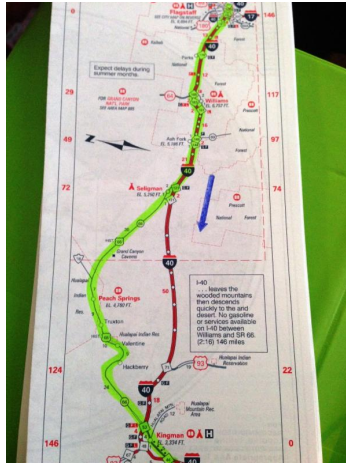

Years ago, members of AAA could get a *TripTik* to help them navigate their way on a vacation or other road trip. The *TripTik* was a series of maps that were bound together by a spiral. Each page was a segment of the trip and when you completed that segment, you were able to flip the page to the next map. In the early stages of a long trip, you felt like you were making progress as you compared the mile markers and exit numbers on the road to your page. But, when you thumbed through all of the pages of maps yet to come, you realized that you still had a long way to go.

That *TripTik* is a good illustration for me. I can look at some areas of my life as a follower of Christ and see some progress, and yet, as I consider what the goal is, I realize that I have a very long way yet to go. The same thing is true for our church. I can look back at our history and praise God for the many milestones that we have accomplished, but, at the same time, realize that we have a very long way yet to travel. It is tempting to only look at one page and feel a sense of accomplishment or see some improvement, but, scenic overlook rest areas on the side of the road are not the goal.

This fall, we are going to look back 500 years and thank God for the recovery of the gospel that marked the Reformation. We are, also, going to look forward and remind ourselves of where we are going because we still have a long road to travel, and we really do not have time to waste.

The good news is that one day we will arrive. Christ has guaranteed that. And, on that day, the little pages of this time will be seen for what they really are. This is no time to slow down, nor is it time to quit. Your pursuit of Christ, your pursuit of growth, your pursuit of gospel fruit, and your efforts to reach others with the gospel are good and

important goals. Press on. Our efforts to grow deeper even as we reach more people, our efforts to raise up and support missionaries, our desire to pay off our indebtedness that we might invest more in missions, church planting, and other ministries are good and important goals. We still have some more pages in the *TripTik* to turn, and we have a lot of people that we need to invite to join us on the trip. It's a long journey, but it's a good one.
