## Bob's Blog

Jewish tradition (oral tradition that was eventually written down, but is not Scripture) says that Joshua married Rahab. While there are some things that we have learned from Jewish tradition that can be helpful, I mentioned in the Morning Worship sermon this past week that we know that Joshua did not marry Rahab. Then I said that whoever, under the age of 18, could tell me the reason (from the Bible) why we know that for certain, would get a free book.

The first person who tried to answer this, answered correctly, but he was over 18. Then kid, after kid, after kid gave it a shot, until one girl, whose brother was home (presumably not feeling well) watching the service through livestreaming, texted her his answer. He correctly said that Joshua was from the tribe of Ephraim and Rahab (according to Matthew 1) married into the tribe of Judah, was the great-grandmother of David, and in the ancestral line of Christ. Therefore, Joshua could not have married Rahab.

I told the girl to go into the bookstore and get whatever book her brother wanted, and I would pay for it. A few minutes later she came out with Gordon Fee and Douglas Stuart's great book on interpreting the Bible called, "How to Read the Bible for All It's Worth." I don't know what I was more excited about: someone getting the answer correct or someone under 18 wanting a book like that? Wow!

This Sunday we begin a series in the book of Judges. This is not a book about heroes and heroines. These are not stories where I can point to the leaders and say, "Follow them." The real hero in the book of Judges is God. In spite of how deeply flawed, broken, and even disgusting some of these leaders are, God keeps His promise to have a people through whom He will bring the Messiah. Oh, there are plenty of times when we look at Satan's efforts to destroy God's work, but Judges is the story of

how God's people are hell-bent on destroying themselves, and would have, except for the grace of God.

I pray that you will see and savor the faithfulness of God even as we gain a renewed appreciation for His commitment to His own glory.
