Bob's Blog

The other night, I went to a Tigers' game along with some of my family. The game was close, the weather was good, and we were enjoying being together, until the 8th inning. I tend to be one of those people who "we have fun when we win." So, when a relief pitcher came in from the Tiger's bullpen, I slumped down in my seat, put my hands on my head, tried to pull my hat over my ears, and shook my head. My daughter asked me what was wrong. I said, "Just watch! He's going to give up a homer to left field and the lead." Thirty seconds later, the opposing batter hit a ball 455 feet into the left field bleachers. Then I said, "The next one is going into the right field bleachers." It only made it to the warning track. After the pitcher gave up a double, the fans were booing so loudly that my two-year old grandson said, "They are angry!"

I do not envy the job of a baseball manager. Every decision he makes is scrutinized by thousands, talked about publicly, and replayed endlessly. Then at the end of every game reporters stick mikes in his face and ask him every conceivable question and plenty of inconceivable ones, too. There are times, when I really wish I could know what he was thinking. Why did he put that guy in there?

This week I've been reading a new book by a friend of mine called, "The Mentoring Church." There is a chapter in it on how the discipleship of Christ to the twelve established a model and practice for the early church. As I thought about some of those early disciples, I realized that most of those guys would be guys you wouldn't want in your bullpen. In other words, when Christ called these guys to follow Him, I have no doubt that some of the angels were slumping in their seats, folding down their wings, and wondering "what on earth was He doing?" (literally) "Why did He pick him?"

I realized that the same thing, and even more so, could be said about me and about you. God in His mercy has called us to follow Him. He has given us the ball of the life of our church, places us on the mound, and tells us to pitch. We may not look all that impressive and the boo-birds will remind us of that. But, here we are. We have a charge to keep, a game to play (that is no game), and a mission to accomplish. Could God have picked someone more accomplished? Sure, but He picked us because it puts His grace on display. But, like a pitcher, we are not alone. We are surrounded by teammates and that is another amazing grace in our lives.

Tonight is another opportunity to meet some more of your teammates. Our family fun event is certainly for fun, but it is so you can meet some more of the team. So, come and appoint yourself as chairman of the welcoming and greeting committee. Make it an intentional goal to meet someone you do not know and do it in the first 15 minutes.
