

Small Group Questions from June 26, 2022

Read Text: 1 Samuel 18:6-16

1. Discuss your overall reaction to the message from Sunday. Did anything “stick with you” throughout this past week?
2. Bob stated that our anger reveals our true beliefs. In what ways does your anger reveal what you value? When is this good? When is this bad? How we respond to our anger is as important as the cause of our anger. What are right and what are sinful ways to respond to anger?
3. Bob state that sinful anger positions us as God’s enemies. What might this mean? What are reasons that we might become angry with God? What is an appropriate way to deal with our anger towards God?
4. Politics are an important part of life. What are examples of politics being used for good? What are examples of politics being used for ill? Why is it wrong for us to trust in political power? Practically, how can we engage with politics wisely without giving our heart over to it?
