

Small Group Questions from Feb. 11, 2024

Read Text: Luke 3:21-22

1. Discuss your overall reaction to the message from Sunday. Did anything “stick with you” throughout this past week?
2. In His baptism Jesus identifies with us. How might it be encouraging to us to know that we have some solidarity with Jesus? The text makes clear, however, that even though Jesus identifies with sinners, He is not Himself a sinner. Why is this an important detail?
3. This text announces Jesus as the most important person in human history and someone worth building your life around. In what ways should we build our lives around Jesus? How have you experienced the benefits of building a life around Jesus? Where do you need to shift priorities to re-center Jesus in your life?
4. Bob encouraged us to reflect on the love of God in Christ that is represented in this text. How does Jesus demonstrate His love for sinners in this account? Why do we struggle at times to accept and live in light of this love? How can you practice accepting this love more fully this week?
