Sermon Text: Luke 22:14-23 (Pt.2)

Follow-Up (Use this for group discussion or pass it along to group for personal reflection later)

Least weeks sermon covered Luke 22:14-23. The point was made briefly in last weeks sermon that followers of Jesus are brought into a fellowship in which we belong to one another and are responsible to help each other follow Jesus. Reflect on you week last week. Is there a particular example you can share of how a brother or sister helped you follow Jesus over the last week?

Sermon Discussion

- Read Luke 22:14-23 together as a group.
 - Try to summarize the text and sermon in a couple of sentences as a group.
 - Review the main points of the sermon together.
1. The word *covenant* is a central word in this text. Have you given much thought to the important role covenants play in helping us understand the storyline of the Bible? How would you describe the difference between a covenant and a contract? What makes the nature of the word covenant so important in describing God's relationship with his people? How does understanding that the storyline of the Bible is based on a series of covenants help us read our Bibles better?
 2. The betrayal and rebellion of Judas ultimately accomplished God's plan. This shows us that the plan of God is never threatened by the schemes of man. Do you ever find it difficult to believe that the rebellion against God that we see in the world is not thwart God's plan? How does this text provide encouragement to the Christian in a world marked by so much rebellion against God?
 3. Judas illustrates the utter folly and personal destruction of rejecting Christ. Do you have family members, friends, or co-workers in your life who reject Christ? What does Christ's warning in verse 22 reveal about the seriousness of rejecting Christ? How can your small group pray for you as you seek to be a gospel witness to those in your life who reject Christ?

Small Group Prayer Points

- Spend time as a group thanking Jesus for his sacrifice.
- Spend time as a group praying for those whom you are seeking to share the gospel with.
- Spend time as a group praising God that he always carries out his good plans in spite of opposition.
